



Joel Rubin Coffee Scoops

I decided to turn a few coffee scoops. The first ones I

made required 2 piece scoops the bowl and handle which would then be glued together. I wasn't happy with the results and consulted the internet and YouTube. All the videos required making a custom jig to hold the scoop on the chuck. I have too many one use jigs so I came up with a design that did not need a custom jig first. I will demonstrate the method at our next meeting.

I am an Emergency Medicine Physician. I have been turning for 18 years. I have made simple bowls to highly pierced thin walled art pieces. I have not stuck to any one style.

TURNING A ONE PIECE COFFEE SCOOP WITHOUT A JIG BY JOEL RUBIN

Turn a 3 x 7 inch round block of wood

Measure 3 inches from tail stock end and part partly down with thin parting tool Turn handle from that cut to head stock end to about 3/4 inch thick

Turn remaining stock into a 3 inch sphere

Accurately find the center of the sphere (on the long axis) and draw a line across both sides. Remount piece with the tail and headstock centered on the line Cut 1/2" tenon on what will be the bottom of the scoop

Chuck the tenon in a narrow jawed chuck

Drill a 1 1/2" hole with a forstner bit 1 1/2" deep Round off the bottom of the hole (final depth 1 5/8" deep) Reverse the scoop and expand the jaws in the hole to turn off the tenon (optional) Remount the scoop as a spindle and turn the handle to 3/8" thick and turn the scoop round as thin as you dare!

Sand top of scoop to make



scoop 1 3/8" deep to make coffee scoop hold 3 scoops of coffee for a 10 cup coffee pot. Sand; Finish of choice.

Put the handle into the narrow jaws and clamp tight Turn off the nub on the bowl; sand and apply finish

SWAT Symposium 2019 August 23 - 25 2019

Each year, the SouthWest Association of Turners (SWAT) holds one of the largest woodturning symposiums in the world. In 2016, over 800 attendees enjoyed this outstanding event in Waco, Texas.

SWAT is an all-volunteer organization which allows the price to remain affordably low. The Symposium features nationally and internationally recognized turners, as well as outstanding regional turners selected from participating clubs and across the country. The next Symposium will again be held at the Waco Convention Center, The SWAT Symposium will offer something for every level of Woodturner.

The Symposium features:

1. An Art Gallery where attendees may display up to 10 art pieces of their work (Some will be for sale).

2. The banquet on Saturday night is highlighted with a drawing for beautiful turned art pieces.

3. A continuation of the drawing (using the same tickets) will be held at noon on Sunday. This drawing will consist of a full size lathe, three midi lathes, a large assortment of woodturning tools and accessories.

4. There will be a myriad of vendors on site selling equipment and supplies at very competitive prices.

5. Lunches are provided during the three-day event for paid attendees.

6. In addition to the many demonstrations, five Special Interest Group sessions are planned.

7. There will be three areas to offer hands-on opportunities to turn something of choice, turn a pen, or sharpen a tool. It is a good opportunity for one-on-one coaching form highly trained turners.

8. Bring your spouse. SWAT will have a full schedule of activities and special classes designed for the non-turning spouse.



Trinity River Woodturners Council

Trinity River Woodturners Council (TRWC) is a new organization that started in the fall of 2018. It started as an idea from two local woodturners, Tod Raines from the Dallas Area Woodturners (DAW) and Ron Howe from Woodturners of North Texas (WNTX). Both Ron and Tod had attended Ron Campbell's Hands-On-Retreat in Michigan in July of 2018. They experienced the retreat from different points of view – Tod as an instructor and Ron as a participant. Both met a lot of new friends, learned a lot and had a wonderful time. From this experience and their desire to share this experience with their local clubs, Tod and Ron kicked off the formation of TRWC and the idea of the local woodturning retreat.

Today the TRWC is an approved chapter of the AAW. Our by-laws require board members from each of the five area clubs - Dallas Area Woodturners (DAW), East Texas Woodturners (ETW), Golden Triangle Woodturners (GTW), Hunt County Woodturners (HCW), and Woodturners of North Texas (WNTX). The mission of TRWC is "to provide education, information and hands on training to those who are interested in woodturning". To accomplish this mission the TRWC brings together the five area clubs to share knowledge, experiences, demonstrators, training opportunities and other woodturning related events. As the name implies the "TRWC Hands-On Woodturning Retreat" is meant to be a relaxing, enjoyable time for woodturners to come together and learn and share ideas through direct practical experience. The event will involve the following:

- up to 40 lathes from mini to full size
- four students/lathes per class
- 10 classes of four students each turning at one time
- four 2 hours sessions a day
- * two full days of turning (a total of eight sessions)
- * up to 40 individual classes per day
- about 25 local instructors, known for their unique project and teaching
- over 26 unique on lathe classes with a large variety of projectbased instruction
- many off lathe activities (some tied to a turned project) including

- pyrography (wood burning)
- power carving and piercing
- airbrushing
- finishing
- * pen segmenting

- photography
- rose engine lathe demonstration
- tools and supply vendors

The TRWC Hands-On Woodturning Retreat will be held on Oct. 18th& 19th, 2019. The location is at the North Lake College West Campus, 1401 Royal Lane West, DFW Airport, TX 75261. The registration for attending this event will open in late July. The setup for the event will take place on Thursday Oct 17th from 12 noon to 5pm. 
