Trinity River Woodturners Council's Hands-On Woodturning Retreat will be on October 18 - 19, 2019 at North Lake College, West Campus located at 1401 West Royal Lane, Irving Texas, 75261.

Thursday October 17th is set up day from noon to 5:00 pm followed by a Meet & Greet for all vendors, instructors, volunteers, and attendees that will include a light meal, drinks and a short woodturning demo. The Hands-On Woodturning Retreat instructional days are Friday October 18 and Saturday October 19 from 8:00 am to 5:30 pm. Currently we will have ten lathe location each with four lathes active throughout the day, each day. Each lathe location will accommodate four attendees and one instructor to turn the project for that session. Each session is a full two hours with four sessions each day, both days (eight sessions in all). Many classes are two part classes that involve both on and off lathe activities. The second part of a two-part class will add embellishments to your turning. These may include carving, piercing, pyrography, air brushing, and finishing. We will also offer photography, pen segmenting, Rose Engine lathe demonstration, dissecting burls and possibly more.
