Scrapers and More - A New Review



It has been said that skilled and professional woodturners don't use scrapers. Well it turns out that is simply not true. Richard Raffan, Stuart Batty, and Cindy Drosda, all highly professional woodturners, have been using scrapers for years as have many others. In fact if you read any of the Richard Raffan books he has pub-

lished you will find that he spends much time talking and demonstrating the use of scrapers. Scrapers are wonderful tools for making end grain boxes and hollow turnings.

Some of us have tried to use scrapers inside bowls with very mixed success. They can cause some very nasty catches that will make you wish that you had never tried them. We have also heard that they should never be used on the outside of a bowl.

In this demo the B-S guys are going to take another look at scrapers. What is a scraper, what type of scrapers are there, where should they be used, how should they be used, how are they sharpened, and what are their benefits and drawbacks. We will demonstrate their usage on both the outside and inside of a bowl and as a hollowing tool for hollow forms.

Come join us as we have fun making shavings with a variety of scrapers.


