# October Virtual Meeting Craig Timmerman



After many years in the computer and software industry, Craig Timmerman has been a full-time artist and production wood turner since 2008. In addition to demonstrating and teaching at many AAW chapters, he has demonstrated at AAW Symposiums, numerous SWAT symposiums, the Utah Symposium, the North Dakota Symposium, and the Rocky Mountain Symposium. He was recently featured in the April edition of the AAW American Woodturner magazine. Craig had started the Armadillo Woodworks YouTube channel and is setup to do remote, interactive demos.

He picked up woodturning over twenty years ago when he took a weekend class at a local store. After that weekend the wood working equip-

store. After that weekend the wood working equipment in his shop ceased to be used for anything except woodturning. His specialties include non-round turnings, hollow forms, spheres, lamps, and production gift items. Many of his pieces combine multiple turnings and bent laminations. He works primarily with reclaimed timber accentuating the flaws by making them the focal point of the piece; often filling them with crushed stone.

Craig's work is in several central Texas galleries and can also be found on his website,

armadillowoodworks.com. He also does a few art shows each year, including the Armadillo Christmas Bazaar-Austin's oldest Christmas art show. He has been married to his wife Tina for over 35 years and they live just outside Austin, TX. If life wasn't busy enough, Craig also sings barbershop and a cappella music.

## **Craig Timmerman Demo**

In this demo I go through the steps of turning a disk-shaped vase, approximately 7" in diameter. The vase is turned on two different axes and has a test tube insert. Each face of the vase has an inlay of contrasting wood. I go through the steps to prep the inlay material and show the steps needed to turn the vase and insert the inlay material in the vase.


