#### Turn a Forest: Ring-Turned Trees

11/2 hours

Let's make some ornaments – lots of them! We will use a technique called "Reifendrehen" or "ring turning". One kind of ring turning (making rings to wear on your fingers) has become popular recently. But that's not what we're doing.



We're doing the other, older style of ring turning: make a large ring (8 to 10" diameter) with the desired profile and slice the ornaments out of the ring. We'll add a step using inside-out turning to create a hollow shape. Using this method, you can quickly make 40 to 50 ornaments at a time. The technique I use is based on an article in the October 2013 issue of American Woodturner.


