It is well known in its use for baseball bats being a straight stable wood and makes good tool handles due to its toughness and shock resistance. Occasionally, figured pieces can be found and can make some pleasant turnings. Overall, it is a cheaper wood to practice on but is nice enough to be able to produce some exceptional art like Tom Gall's vessel featured in the AAW forum gallery.

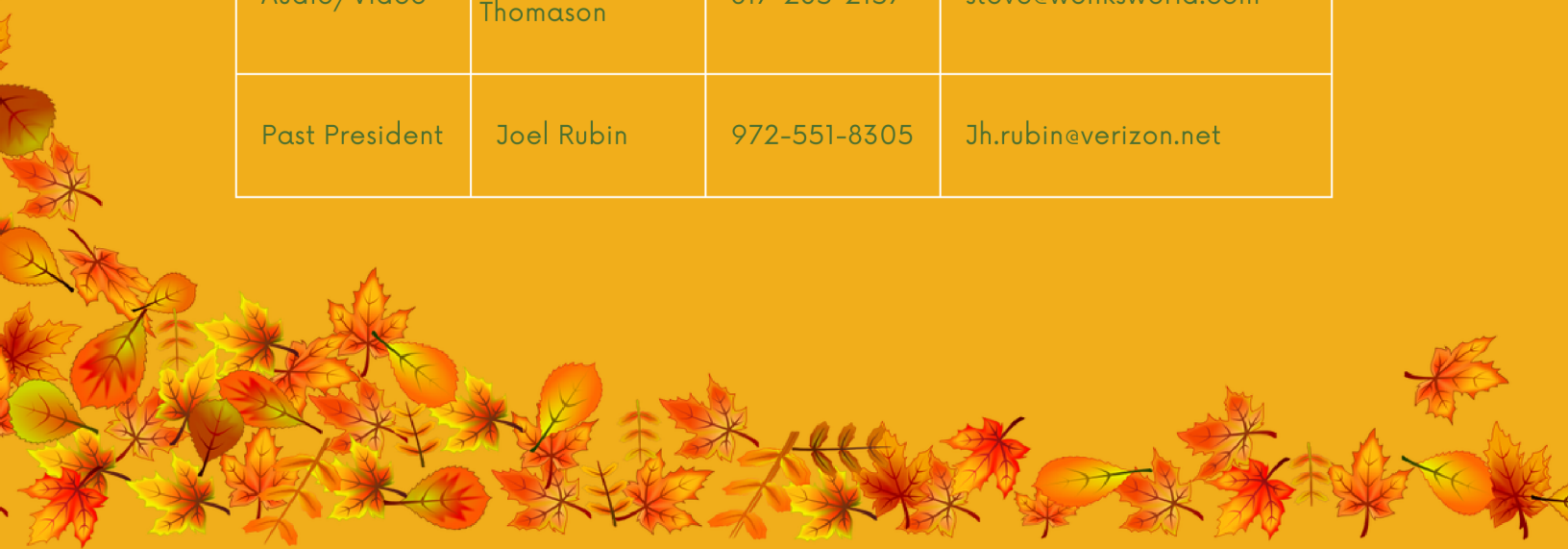

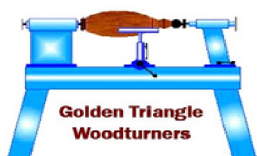
