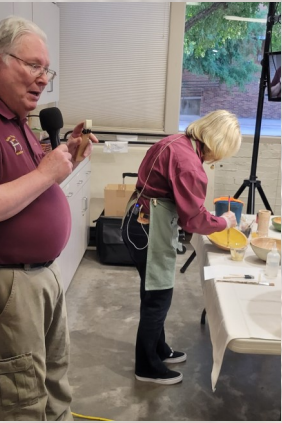

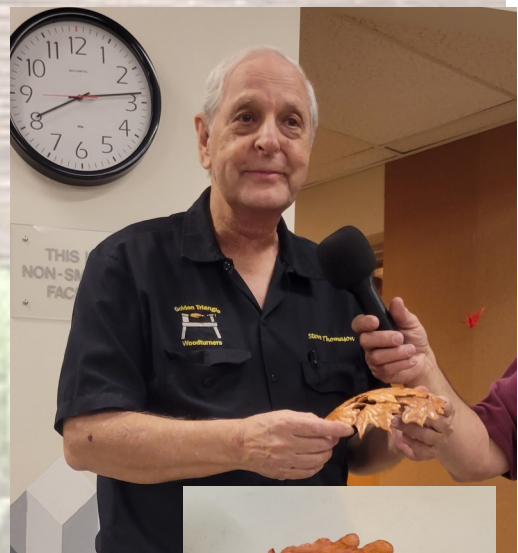

Sycamore is an underrated wood in my opinion. It is similar to maple in that it is mostly sapwood with some darker heartwood streaks. It's a light tan to white color and has unusual flecks on quartersawn blanks resembling lacewood. It does turn and take dyes very nicely.
