

3/8" or 10mm offset

Dark 1.50"(37 mm) offset represents tenon on back side

- 1. Mount between centers and turn Round.
- 2. With Top toward the tail stock mounted on center, turn and finish the top. Turn, sand, and finish the edge.
- 3. Turn blank around and mount off center. Bottom toward the tail stock
- 4. Turn a tenon to fit your chuck. I use 1.50" or 37 mm.
- 5. Start shaping the bottom and determine how thick the edge should be. Cut the bottom of the bowl to approximate size. Do not make too small. Leave a small flat around the tenon for mounting in chuck.
- 6. Turn blank around and mount in chuck by the tenon
- 7. Turn the inside of the bowl to the size you want. Do not turn through the bottom shape you cut earlier.
- 8. Sand and finish the inside of the bowl. You won't be able to come back to it later
- 9. Turn around and jam chuck or vacuum chuck and finish the bottom
